HOW DOES TIERED PRICING WORK?

We offer tiered pricing as a way for families to invest in our camp and facilities. There are three voluntary price options, and you can choose the option that best fits your family's financial situation.

Tier C represents the full cost of operating camp and long-term maintenance to our facilities; **Tier B** covers all of the basic camp costs and contributes to long-term costs; **Tier A** covers the basic cost of camp.
