**We continue to make preparations for a full schedule of summer programs at Camp Sealth.** Registration remains open for all camps that have spots available.

We recognize how difficult it is right now to make decisions about your summer plans, as public health directives evolve day by day. With that in mind, **we are extending the deadline for summer camp deposit refunds until at least May 1.** This means that your deposit will continue to hold your child's spot at camp for one additional month.
