I hope that you are staying safe and healthy during these challenging times! This is quick update to let you know about the changes to our refund/cancellation policy, and what to expect over the next couple of weeks as we solidify our plans for the summer.

Cancellation deadline moved to June 1

A few weeks ago, we posted the updated refund/cancellation policy on our website. You have until **June 1** to cancel your registration and receive a full refund including the deposit. If you cancel after June 1 up to two weeks before camp begins, you are eligible for a full refund less the deposit. If we have to cancel a program, you will receive a full refund unless you choose to donate or credit your payments to a program for next year. Awaiting Guidance
