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CAMP SEALTH - 2022 Info Sheet



Location

Camp Sealth is on 360 acres of pristine forest, wetlands, and over a mile of saltwater beach on Colvos Passage. We are located on the southwest shore of Vashon Island, which is accessible by ferry from Seattle, Tacoma, and Port Orchard.

Cabins

Our cabins are semi-rustic, typically with 8-10 beds per room and separate, nearby bathhouses. About half of the cabins are winterized for year-round use; others are open-air that can be used May to September.

Program Activities

We offer a variety of program activities to meet the needs of your group, including:

- Low ropes
- Archery
- Bouldering wall
- Teambuilding
- Outdoor living skills
- Guided hikes
- Arts & crafts
- Outdoor education curriculum
- Boating/fishing/swimming
- Marine touch tanks

Some activities are seasonal and depend on staffing availability.

How To Book

We can book groups up to one year in advance. Contact us to inquire about available dates and we will send you an estimate based on your group's needs. A signed contract and deposit is required to hold your reservation.

Dates/Availability

Camp Sealth is available for rental September through mid-June. April/May and September/October offer the best weather and selection of program options, although they are also the busiest.

Lodges & Meeting Rooms

Rounds Hall: The dining hall and main meeting room for main camp, it can seat up to 400 people. Rounds Hall usage is included for main camp groups or can be rented separately.

Parsons' Lodge: The dining room and main meeting room for Wrangler, it can seat up to 60 people. Parsons' usage is included for Wrangler groups or can be rented separately.

Several other meeting rooms are available in main camp that can each hold between 10-25 people; some with fireplaces/couches, TVs, or small kitchenettes.

Group Requirements

Groups booking camp for a retreat or for Outdoor Education must be associated with a school, church, non-profit organization or government group which can provide insurance coverage for the event. We can also book a limited amount of weddings (contact us for separate pricing sheet). Groups can be sized between 20 to 400.

Basic Amenities

All group rentals have access to the following basic amenities:

- 24-hour manager on duty
- Limited A/V equipment
- Tables/chairs/benches
- Coffee/tea service (with food service)
- Meeting rooms
- Firewood
- Sports equipment
- Use of all outdoor spaces: beach, trails, playfields, amphitheaters, volleyball court, etc.

Other Things to Know

- Alcohol is allowed only for pre-approved events hosted by a licensed bartender.
- Guests may not use the docks, boats, waterfront, or go swimming unless supervised by a camp staff lifeguard. Usage of the water must be approved before the event.
- Our cabin facilities do not include bedding; guests must bring their own linens or sleeping bags.
- Vashon Island is accessible by ferry only. Groups must factor in transportation/ferry fees into their event. We cannot provide shuttle service to/from ferries.
